

## **PEI News Scrapbook Assignment**

For the next month or so, you will all become news watchers. This will help you keep in touch with current issues of the day on PEI.

### **Steps to follow:**

1. You will be expected to check The Guardian every day for specific articles. You will need 2 articles for each category. You may use the class sets of papers I will provide.
2. Clip articles you decide to use and check off the list below to keep you organized. Be sure to keep them somewhere safe so they may be placed into your scrapbook.
3. Compile your scrapbook.  
Clearly label the heading for each article/letter/cartoon included  
Tape/glue etc. each article etc. into your scrapbook.  
Below/beside each article/letter/cartoon include a summary that fully explains it.  
Don't be too brief, or too wordy.

Your finished product should be neat, organized and nicely presented. Proper spelling, grammar, usage etc. is expected.
